# NOTES FROM THE ARCHIVES

In 1910, Cochrane Street congregation found free labour and sufficient money to erect a Day School in the Battery. Miss May Cooper was hired to be the teacher. By 1913 there were 50 scholars on the Roll. In 1916, the church bought land in the Flavin Road / King's Road area to build a larger school. Records show that this did not materialize and subsequently, the land was sold in 1921 for \$6000 to the St. John's East Methodist Board of Education for erection of a school under their jurisdiction.
