NOTES FROM THE ARCHIVES

Our Sunday School in 1950 (Part One)

Mr. Robert S. Maunder, the Superintendent, reported on the Sunday School. The School held 53 sessions with an average attendance of 26 officers and teachers and an average student attendance of 256 out of 387 on the roll. Promotion Sunday was held on Jan 7, with other special Sundays being Easter, Mother’s Day, Missionary Sunday, Rally Day and White Gift Sunday.

Eleven children were eligible for church membership. The Cradle Roll under the leadership of Mrs. Fred. Purchase had 266 young children on their list. At age four, these children joined the Sunday School.

The Beginners’ Class was led by Miss Ruby Steele with her assistants Dorothy Knight and Dorothy Verge. They reported an enrolment of 94 with the usual attendance being over 60 children.

Miss Ella Adey led the Primary Class assisted by Miss M. Bradbury. They also reported 60 children as being the usual number attending each week.
