The first church was destroyed by fire on Sunday night, January 18, 1914, shortly after the end of the evening service. The night was snowy and windy which later changed to rain, thus protecting the nearby houses from catching fire. The fire was nearly extinguished by midnight and by morning, the church had been reduced to rubble. The cause was never determined.
