Part 2

Cochrane Street Board of Trustees met on January 19, 1914, to make plans for the congregation and to move forward with re-building of the church. The congregation met in the Methodist College Hall on Long's Hill at nominal rent for Sunday morning and evening services as well as Sunday School in the afternoons. The Rector of St. Thomas Anglican Church offered the use of Canon Wood Hall for mid-week afternoon and evening services and meetings.
