NOTES FROM THE ARCHIVES

For the next several weeks I will be sharing some information about some of the men listed on our Honour Rolls.

Last week I noted that Stoker 2nd Class William Thomas Newell died when the HMS Penzance was torpedoed off the coast of Iceland on August 24, 1940. Also serving on that ship and who died on the same day was Stoker 1st Class Claude Maxwell Percy, Service Number P/KX 98862.

He was the son of Azariah and Tamar Percy, of St. John's and was 20 years old at the time of his death. He is remembered at the Portsmouth Naval Memorial, Hampshire, United Kingdom.
