UPDATE FROM THE CSUC TRANSITION TEAM OF CHURCH COUNCIL

A meeting was held between the CSUC Transition Team and Cochrane Centre on Monday August 21, 2017 regarding an update on the Annex area of the building. The Cochrane Centre has advised that the Occupancy Permit is close at hand and they anticipate occupying the Annex or back hall portion of the Centre by mid to late September. In anticipation of these dates and the issuance of an Occupancy Permit sometime in September, the Transition Team is requesting a meeting of the Church Council and representatives from the congregation's service groups and organizations to review and discuss with the Cochrane Centre, space requirements and logistical matters relating to occupying and utilizing the annex. At this time the Cochrane Centre will also provide an update on the progress of the work.

It is requested that two representative from each of the service groups and organizations attend the meeting to review and discuss the space, furniture, equipment, supplies and related logistical matters. The meeting is scheduled for Wednesday August 30, 2017 at 7:00 pm at Cochrane Street United Church. The meeting will begin in the sanctuary and then there will be a tour of the space.

The Cochrane Centre has also advised that they will hosting a series of focus group discussions in September to respond to what the Cochrane Centre is planning. One of these focus groups is specifically for the congregation. This focus group is scheduled for Sunday September 17, 2017 after worship service. Further information on the focus session will be forthcoming from the Cochrane Centre.
