

Parking Lot Update: There was a delay in starting the project which was largely due to a Bell Aliant line that runs directly under the current parking lot. We have been working with Bell and the contractor to be very careful when digging not to disturb the line until Bell's engineers finish their plan for moving the line overhead. Another surprise was a large tree stump with an extensive root system that wrapped around the line. This required manual labor to separate the roots from the line and cut the stump in to several pieces to have it removed. The ground composition has also presented a challenge. The engineer was on site to confirm that the ground being excavated could not be re-used to support the paving. Everything had to be removed and then filled with a more appropriate material. The anticipated completion date of August 9th.

Sanctuary Update:

We had scheduled for sanctuary repairs to begin on July 2. The contractor requested to leave scaffolding up until the following Monday, as it was the only time he could get his employees to set this up. There was a wedding scheduled for that weekend, so that was deemed inappropriate. The contractor felt that they would not be able to finish the work before the next scheduled wedding in August so they backed out of the contract. We are currently seeking another contractor to scrape, plaster, and paint the ceiling underneath the balcony. After consulting with a restoration company "Marlerworks" it was suggested that we invest in draping for the corners

that are the most seriously damaged and wait for a more significant financial contribution before taking on the restoration work required there. They felt that it was not the best use of funds to begin restoring those corners, and sadly we agree. We are working hard on securing bigger dollars to restore and enhance the capacity of the sanctuary as soon as possible! We are hoping to have draping and some basic painting completed before mid-August.

BAG TO SCHOOL: Bridges to Hope is once again reaching out to our faith-based community with a request for specific school supplies. We are hoping you can help us to help students get a good start in 2019. This year we are asking for donations of **Scientific Calculators by August 19**. They can be delivered to Bridges to Hope from 9am-1:30pm Monday to Friday. If this is not convenient, CSUC's administrative assistant will gladly deliver them. Drop them off at the church main office Sunday or Tuesday to Thursday from 10am-3pm.
