### NOTES FROM THE ARCHIVES

The Service of Lessons and Carols, has long been a tradition in our church. This was originally an evening service, changing in 1971 to both morning and evening. However, in 1974 the choir presented its carol service during the morning service only, the tradition we follow today. For several years during the 1960s our choir travelled to All Saints Anglican Church, Foxtrap and St. Peters Anglican Church, Upper Gullies where they repeated the Service of Lessons and Carols, with their choirs joining ours.
