

#### **NOTES FROM THE ARCHIVES**

Laying of the Cornerstone of our first church - September 7, 1880 (Part 2)

And handing the jar to Mrs. Shenton, the Rev. Gentleman [Rev J Shenton] said, - "I hand this glass jar to you to deposit in a cavity beneath the corner-stone." He then handed to her a silver trowel and mallet, and said,- "I hand these to you to lay well and truly this corner-stone, as symbolical of the firmness, and durability of the doctrines to be preached in this church, and the religious life to be enjoined and enjoyed."

The stone was then lowered to its place, and, having touched it with the mallet, she said, - "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost, I lay this corner-stone for the foundation of a house to be builded and consecrated to the service of Almighty God, according to the order and usages of the Methodist Church in Canada.-Amen." (From the Evening Telegram September 8, 1880) [Having a woman lay a cornerstone at that time was seen as an oddity.]
