

NOTES FROM THE ARCHIVES

On June 2, 1961, Pine Hill Divinity Hall held convocation at Cochrane Street. At that time, Doctor of Divinity, Honoris Causa, was conferred on Rev Levi Donald Curtis and Bachelor of Divinity on Rev Donovan Leish Brown. Rev Curtis, known as LAD Curtis, was our minister from 1959 to 1965.
