

NOTES FROM THE ARCHIVES

A NEW BEGINNING! Fourth of 9 Parts

The contractor for the building was the Downing Cook Company of Toronto. The final cost of the contract work was \$82,413, the terms of the contract being \$80,000 plus 10%. Furnishings added another \$7000. Construction was completed by Feb 19, 1916 with all the floors laid, stained and oiled, the woodwork finished and the scaffolding removed.
