

NOTES FROM THE ARCHIVES

Our final women's group, Time out for Women, was formed by our Christian Education coordinator, Donna Landry, in 1983 as a six week program for mothers and young children. It quickly became a weekly get together for women of all ages, not all of whom belonged to our congregation. It had no officers or constitution and changed as the needs or wants of the members changed. Its primary purpose was fellowship but was also involved in fundraising for capital projects rather than ongoing expenses. The group continued until 2015 when it disbanded because of the deaths of many of the members, some of whom were involved from the beginning.

In 2015 the group was able to contribute over \$20,000 to the congergation for roof repairs. Most of this came from the very popular Summer Thursdays at Cochrane – a luncheon hosted for five years often accompanied by organ recitals.
