

NOTES FROM THE ARCHIVES

Much building work has been done throughout the 105 years on the church building. In 1930, the roof over the church vestibule at the main entrance was repaired. The waterproof surface was intact but underneath the joist and deck had rotted. The total cost to replace this damaged wood, cover it with a waterproof material and a layer of gravel as well as incidental repair to the copper flashing disturbed during the repair work was \$300 (about \$4,600 today).
