

NOTES FROM THE ARCHIVES

Next year, 2022, is the 140th anniversary of our congregation worshiping on Cochrane Street. I thought it might be interesting to look back 40 years. All "Notes" from November 14 to December 19 are taken from the 1982 Annual Report.

The United Church Women was an active organization in 1982 with a membership of 94, divided into 6 units. In this small space, it is impossible to describe all the work of the women. However, here are just a few extracted from their 6-page report: monthly visits to Glenbrook Lodge, visits to the lonely and sick, support of a foster child, maintain a nursey roll and send birthday cards, care for the nursey space and contents, help with Junior choir, raise funds, support social functions in the church.
