

NOTES FROM THE ARCHIVES

Board of Stewards: May 17, 1916: "Mr Cushman from the Valley City Seating Company, Toronto, has reached the city while the *SS Tobasco* with the pews, communion rail / platform, pulpit and minister's platform, choir screen and trichairs, organ screen and components is due this morning."

And on June 6, 1916: "Mr Cushman installed seats, pulpit, etc. but not the organ screen."

(These components cost \$4275 in 1916 and in today's dollars they would cost \$81, 581.)
